## Residential Treatment

24-hour therapeutic support for children with emotional and behavioral challenges and those with neurological differences — we give them what they need to succeed and become stable members of their communities through programs at:

- Child & Family Healing Center
- Leland House

## Special Needs Education & Career Development

Elementary, middle, and high school students with neurological differences and emotional, behavioral, social and learning challenges receive therapeutic education at:

- Charterhouse School – Richmond (for residential and day students)
- Charterhouse School – Edinburg (for day students)




## Foster Care & Adoption

Support and resources for adoptive and foster families through:

- Treatment foster care for children and teens
- Adoption services to provide children with a safe, loving home
- Adoptive Family Preservation, which serves adoptive families no matter where or when the adoption took place

## Community-Based Services

Helping families find support within their home communities through:

- Customized support for families in crisis
  - Intensive recruitment to identify lifelong connections for children
  - Therapeutic mentoring to provide positive role models for children and teens
  - Therapeutic day treatment in public schools
  - Project LIFE, which serves teens transitioning out of foster care
